TRANSPORTATION:

IATA jet economy class, applicable on American Airlines, based on the Chicago to Delhi non refundable APEX fare for a group based on a 7 day, 3 month fare allowing no stopovers.

MEALS AND SIGHTSEEING:

Three meals daily in hotels or compound except where noted.

NOT INCLUDED:

Visas are not included in total cost of trip. Transportation between hometown and ORD, any items of a personal nature such as laundry, phone calls, tips for personal favors, any costs resulting from absence or deviation from the itinerary and any items not shown herein as being included.

PAYMENTS:

A reservation (non-refundable) deposit of \$200 is required. The balance of the tour cost is due 45 days prior to departure. Payment can be made by check, money order or credit card (a fee applies for using a credit card). If travel does not occur, \$150 of deposit may be carried over to another trip with TCWM.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND:

In the event of cancellation after ticketing of international air, airline penalties are in effect. Refund (less cancellation charges imposed by the airlines and hotels) will be made for cancellation within 60 days of the departure date. On or after the date of departure, there can be no refund for any service not used. All cancellation notifications must be made in writing to Integrity Travel Inc. by the dates specified.

INSURANCE AND VISA:

Insurance which is required by the IMB of the SBC is included in this package as well as visa & departure tax costs.

ITINERARY

DAY 1 - JANUARY 28, 2010 - THUR

We will make arrangements for your early morning travel to Chicago where you will take the shuttle bus to the Radisson Hotel. We will finish sorting and packing all medical supplies. All meals are on your own today.

DAY 2 - JANUARY 29, 2010 - FRI

This is a very full day. Orientation will begin immediately following breakfast and will include:

- A time of focused prayer;
- Introduction of each team member;
- Testimonies from new team members;
- Orientation sessions for team leaders and preachers, medical and dental personnel, children's ministry personnel, and clinic evangelism personnel;

In addition, each team will meet separately for a time of orientation with their team leader. Every person is expected to attend all of the orientation segments. Transfer to airport for departure.

DAY 3 - JANUARY 30, 2010 - SAT

Arrive in India the evening and transfer to hotel for overnight.

DAY 4 - JANUARY 31, 2010 - SUN

Following breakfast we will travel to our areas of ministry.

BLR Group — (BANGALORE, ANATHAPUR & DHARMAPURI Areas) Leave for Bangalore to your place to stay for the week. Anathapur and Dharmapuri groups will travel to your destination.

VISAKHAPATNAM Group — (BOBBILI, NEE-LAYAMMA CHOULTRY & KORUKONDA Teams) Fly to Visakhapatnam. Upon arrival we will be transported by a bus to all designated areas, arriving in time for dinner and overnight.

DAY 5 -14 FEBRUARY 1-10, 2010 - MON – WED

In most areas, you will be working in tribal villages. You will depart each morning at 9:00 am to hold clinics and crusades in your assigned area until approximately 4:00 pm. Sunday there will not be clinics but we will hold services in local churches.

DAY 15 - FEBRUARY 11, 2010 - THURS

This morning we begin our journey home. Depart for Delhi where we will be met and transferred to the hotel for rest and relaxation.

DAY 16 - FEBRUARY 12, 2010 - FRI

This morning we will have our "VICTORY BREAKFAST" We'll have a time of rejoicing over the events that happened in India. Each team will report. This afternoon we'll have time for shopping. Transfer to the airport at 9:00 pm.

DAY 17 - FEBRUARY 13, 2010 - SAT

Depart for Chicago in the early morning. Arrive in Chicago next morning. We will make your connecting flight home.

2010 India Crusades, Bible Clubs and Medical Clinics

CRUSADES:

The distance traveled each day for the clinics can vary therefore crusades will be held during the day. Team leaders will be asked to coordinate each service which will contain preaching, music, testimonies and time with the children. Each team member will participate in the crusade through giving their testimony, providing music, or helping with children's time. It is not uncommon for entire villages to attend the day-time crusade where large numbers of persons accept Christ. Following the service, the team will pray for those with special needs, including healing.

STREET PREACHING:

In some areas, following the daily crusades, preachers will have opportunities to preach on the streets of the villages. This is often very productive.

BOARDING SCHOOL BIBLE CLUBS:

Team members will teach Bible stories, play games, and lead creative learning activities. A member from each team will be responsible for coordinating activities, and collecting and transporting supplies.

MOBILE CLINICS:

Mobile clinics meet a variety of medical needs. Clinics may provide medical, dental and/or eye care. Each clinic will treat physical needs, while also addressing spiritual needs. Teams will offer the gospel, one-on-one, with each patient. More than one-third of all professions of faith will take place in the clinics.

NOTE: It's a nice gesture to take a gift from your home town to the pastor and translator as a token of appreciation.

MONEY: New bills are better than travelers checks. Please wear a money belt.

 - Men** - dress pants/kaki's with shirt and tie.
- **Travel** - Wear comfortable clothing.
- **Additional Luggage Needed:** Plan to take an additional suitcase for medical supplies.
- **Needed supplies:** A list of needed supplies for the trip will be mailed to team members prior to the trip. Team members are encouraged to include their church and/or friends in the mission effort by asking for help in gathering the needed supplies.
