### AIR TRANSPORTATION:

IATA jet economy class, applicable on American Airlines, based on the Miami to Lima non-refundable APEX fare for a group based on a 7 day, 3 month fare allowing no stopovers.

### MEALS AND SIGHTSEEING:

Three meals daily in hotels or seminary except where noted.

### COSTS NOT INCLUDED:

Items not included in trip price are: Transportation between hometown and Miami any items of a personal nature (such as laundry, phone calls, tips for personal favors), any costs resulting from absence or deviation from the itinerary and any items not shown herein as being included.

### PAYMENTS:

A reservation (non-refundable) deposit of \$200 is required. The balance of the tour cost is due 45 days prior to departure. If travel does not occur, \$150 of deposit may be carried over to another trip with TCWM.

### CANCELLATION AND REFUND:

In the event of cancellation after ticketing of international flight, airline penalties are in effect. A doctor's certified statement for medical cancellation may void these airline penalties. Refund (less cancellation charges imposed by the airlines and hotels) will be made for cancellation within 60 days of the departure date. On or after the date of departure, there can be no refund for any service not used. All cancellation notifications must be made in writing to Integrity Travel Inc. by the dates specified.

### INSURANCE AND VISA:

Insurance which is required by the IMB of the SBC is included in this package. NO VISA IS REQUIRED FOR THIS TRIP.

# ITINERARY

## FLIGHT SCHEDULES

### *DAY 1 August 2, 2010: Monday*

- The TCWM office will assist you in making these flight arrangements to ensure your connections in Miami. **If you choose to make your own domestic flight arrangements, please contact our office first.**
- **Depart MIAMI to LIMA** - After arriving in Lima we will transfer to a hotel for a night's rest before returning to the airport later this morning.

### *DAY 2 August 3, 2010: Tuesday*

- We will transfer to the domestic terminal for our flights to Trujillo, Piura, Arequipa or Chiclayo. We will transfer to our hotel or to the seminary. This evening we will have orientation.

### *DAYS 3-10 August 4-11, 2010: Wed - Wed*

- During the day we will conduct medical clinics and children's Bible clubs in areas where churches are being planted. Each night evangelistic crusades will be conducted, where you will give your testimony, sing, work with children and preach.

### *DAY 11 August 12, 2010: Thursday*

- After a day of missions work we will depart for Lima where we will be met and transferred to the hotel.

### *DAY 12 August 13, 2010: Friday*

- Today is reserved for shopping in the Peruvian Indian markets. Lunch is on your own today. **Victory Celebrations** will be held tonight in Lima.

### *DAY 13 August 14, 2010: Saturday*

- We will depart Lima and arrive in Miami where you will connect with your domestic flight home.

## What to Bring

- **Medical Team:** Scrubs are clothing of choice during clinics.
- **Men:** Lightweight pants & shirts
- **Women:** Casual clothes for everyday, be prepared to wear dresses for some church services.
- **Men and Women:** Pack clothing suitable for cool to cold weather. No need to over pack. Comfortable walking shoes are a must!
- **Church on Sunday:**
  - Women** - dresses/shirt and skirt some churches you can wear dress pants
  - Men** - dress pants/khaki's with shirt and tie.
- **Travel:** Wear comfortable clothing.
- **Additional Luggage Needed:** Plan to take an additional suitcase for medical supplies.
- **Needed supplies:** A list of needed supplies for the trip will be mailed to team members prior to the trip. Team members are encouraged to include their church and/or friends in the mission effort by asking for help in gathering the needed supplies.
- **Money:** New bills are better than travelers checks.

## 2010 Peru Bible Clubs and Medical Clinics

### EVANGELISTIC SERVICES:

Evangelistic services will be held in area churches and new church starts. Team leaders will coordinate preaching, music, testimonies and children's time for each of the services. Each team member will participate in the evangelistic services giving their testimony, music or helping with children's time.

### CHILDREN'S BIBLE CLUBS:

Team members will teach Bible stories, play games, and lead creative learning activities. A member from each team will be responsible for coordinating activities, and collecting and transporting supplies.

### MOBILE CLINICS:

Mobile clinics meet a variety of medical needs. Clinics may provide medical, dental and/or eye care. Each clinic will treat physical needs, while also addressing spiritual needs. Teams will offer the gospel, one-on-one, with each patient. More than one-third of all professions of faith will take place in the clinics.

### FOOD AND LODGING:

Team members will be staying in hotels, dorm rooms at the seminary or missionary housing. Breakfast will be served in the location where each team stays. Some team members will be served lunch at the seminary. Other team members will receive lunch at area churches, while others will receive a sack lunch. Dinner will be served at local churches, restaurants or the seminary; depending on the area where the team will be serving. The Peruvian food served at every location is delicious and enjoyed by all.
