

Tom Cox World Ministries was organized in 1971 with the distinct purpose of taking the Gospel to people in the United States and around the world who have seldom or never heard the Gospel of Jesus our Savior.

International Missions

Since that time, over 170 teams have been sent by Tom Cox World Ministries to 117 countries of the world. At this time they have ongoing ministries in India, Peru, Kenya, Uganda, Chile, and Cuba. The ministry is sending approximately ten teams a year to International Mission Points. Some of these trips have been approved by the International Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention.

Revivals in North American

Tom and Kay have personally served in over 1,600 "Revivals" in 49 of the United States. They made a promise to the Lord to spend at least two months each year on the "North American Mission Field," which they have fulfilled since 1981. They are in 30 - 40 churches each year in America.

Meet Tom & Kay

Tom has been active in ministry since 1956, 15 years as a pastor in Alabama, Louisiana, Missouri and Oklahoma.

Celebrating 37 years as a full-time Vocational Mission Evangelists in 2008:

- Preached over 1600 revival crusades.
- Traveled to 117 countries of the world and held crusades in 50 of those countries.
- Traveled to the Middle East 34 times leading Bible Land Groups, and Prayer-walking Teams
- Organized the Tom Cox India Ministries in India in 1982 which now has a staff of 150 people with daily on-going ministries.
- Taken Mission Teams to India every year since 1982.
- Served as Vice President of the Oklahoma Baptist Evangelists; organized the Arkansas Baptist Evangelists and served as President five years; served as an officer of the Conference of Southern Baptist Evangelists eight years, two of those as President; past President of the Fellowship of Baptist World Ministries; working closely with the International Mission Board.
- Tom holds a Doctorate of Ministries from Luther Rice Seminary and an honorary Doctorate of Ministry from Tom Cox Baptist Theological Seminary in Trujillo, Peru; a Master of Religious Education from New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary and a Bachelor of Arts from Samford University in Birmingham, AL; attended Clark Memorial College; Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, KY.

Kay works closely with her husband, Tom, as they travel around the world as an evangelistic team. Tom and Kay sing together in crusades. They have made 15 Gospel recordings and have sung before many Associational and State Meetings and twice before the Southern Baptist Convention. Kay has produced two children's albums.

Kay has a very effective children's ministry. A few minutes is dedicated to the children each night at the crusades and each week there is a special children's night. Together they have seen thousands of children come to know the Lord through her ministry.

Kay attended the University of Idaho, Link's School of Business in Boise, Idaho and the International Travel Institute of Tulsa. Kay received an honorary Doctor's Degree from the Tom Cox Baptist Theological Seminary of Peru in 2007. She serves as the Coordinator for the Tom Cox World Ministries around the world.

Financial Policy

We are often asked, what is your policy concerning revivals? We appreciate and share your concerns in these matters. For your information, Tom Cox World Ministries financial policy is listed below:

1. We will minister in any church, regardless of size, with one purpose in mind - "the proclamation of the Gospel."
2. We accept opportunities to serve and minister on a first come, first served basis as the Lord gives direction.
3. Tom Cox World Ministries is a 5013C Tax Exempt, Non-Profit Organization and we minister by faith on a love offering basis. Because this is our only financial support, we ask the pastor to share our financial needs with his people in each service. Knowing that pastors are spiritual leaders, we believe if the people are aware then they will be obedient unto God to give.
4. We request that a love offering be taken in every service in support of our ministry.
5. We request that the church provide:
 - a. Travel expenses (.48 cents per mile, one way from the church previously served) *can vary with fuel prices*
 - b. Lodging (\$50 per night for RV use or a hotel)
 - c. Meals (except breakfast)
 This is to be over and above the love offering. Travel expenses and lodging are to be paid upon arrival, if possible. This is negotiable.
