## MEALS AND SIGHTSEEING:

## COSTS NOT INCLUDED:

Items not included in trip price are: Transportation between hometown and Houston any items of a personal nature (such as laundry, phone calls, tips for personal favors), any costs resulting from absence or deviation from the itinerary and any items not shown herein as being included.

## PAYMENTS:

A reservation (non-refundable) deposit of \$200 is required. The balance of the tour cost is due 45 days prior to departure. If travel does not occur, \$150 of deposit may be carried over to another trip with TCWM.

## CANCELLATION AND REFUND:

In the event of cancellation after ticketing of international flight, airline penalties are in effect. Refund (less cancellation charges imposed by the airlines and hotels) will be made for cancellation within 60 days of the departure date. On or after the date of departure, there can be no refund for any service not used. All cancellation notifications must be made in writing to Integrity Travel Inc. by the dates specified.

- **Men** - Lightweight pants & shirts
- **Women** - Casual clothes for everyday (no shorts).
- **Men and Women:** Pack clothing suitable for hot weather. No need to over pack. Comfortable walking shoes are a must!
- **Church on Sunday :**
  - **Women** - dresses/shirt and skirts
  - **Men** - dress pants/khaki's with shirt and tie.
- **Travel** - Wear comfortable clothing.
- **Additional Luggage Needed:** Plan to take an additional suitcase for medical supplies.
- **Other:** Hats, sunscreen, umbrella or rain gear

## 2010 Africa Evangelism Events and Medical Clinics

### EVANGELISM EVENTS:

Evangelistic services will be held outside, in area churches and new church starts. Team leaders will be asked to coordinate each service which will contain preaching, music, testimonies and time with the children. Each team member will participate in the evangelistic services through giving their testimonies, music, or helping with children's time.

### CHILDREN'S BIBLE CLUBS:

Team members will lead Bible clubs which will include Bible stories, games, and creative learning activities. A member from each team will be responsible for coordinating activities, and collecting and transporting supplies.

### MOBILE CLINICS:

Mobile clinics meet a variety of medical needs. Clinics may provide medical, dental and/or eye care. Each clinic will treat physical needs, while also addressing spiritual needs. Teams will offer the gospel, one-on-one, with each patient. More than half of all professions of faith will take place in the clinics.

### LODGING:

We will be staying at a Guest House we will have breakfast and dinner there, lunch will be a sack lunch. There is not large varieties of food available so you might want to bring a few snacks from home.
