Her first solo was recorded at the age of 3, on the LP record, *Cox's Army Sings Inspirational Music*. She has been singing ever since. Gaye attended Oklahoma State University and Ouachita Baptist University where she majored in music performance.

Music for Gaye is not an end, but a means of communicating a passionate message of God's love, forgiveness, and faithfulness. Gaye recorded the CD, "Faithful", in 2005, and is in the processes of recording a new project, "Tell Them", which focuses on inspiring others to daily live on mission with God.

Gaye and her husband, Eric, are full-time evangelists. Eric Ramsey is the president of Tom Cox World Ministries. They travel the globe leading others to evangelize people groups around the world. Their love for the local church gives them the desire to see the church be on mission for God. Eric and Gaye have two teenage children, Andrew and Alisha. They make their home not far from in Mountainburg, Arkansas and Fort Smith Lake, enjoying a beautiful view of the Boston Mountains.

Kay was born in Boise, Idaho and is the daughter of former mayor and first lady of Boise, Jay and Martha Amyx. Her father helped establish the Southern Baptist work in the Utah-Idaho Convention. Kay gave her life to Jesus at the age of 9; then at 13 answered God's call to missions. She was unaware she would later marry Dr. Tom Cox and that together they would become International Mission Evangelists.

Kay serves full-time with the Tom Cox World Ministries speaking, coordinating children's ministry during crusades, and singing. In addition she oversees the administrative staff and serves as bookkeeper, and missions logistics coordinator.

Tom and Kay Cox own and operate Integrity Travel, Inc. and design Bible Land tours and international mission trips. Kay has traveled in 118 countries and all 50 states.
