Meet Gaye Ramsey



Gaye Ramsey grew up as the youngest child in an evangelistic gospel singing family, *Cox's Army*. Her first solo was recorded at the age of 3, on the LP record, *Cox's Army Sings Inspirational Music*. She has been singing ever since. Gaye attended Oklahoma State University and Ouachita Baptist University where she majored in music performance.

Music for Gaye is not an end, but a means of communicating a passionate message of God's love, forgiveness, and faithfulness. Gaye recorded the CD, "Faithful", in 2005 and is in the process of recording a new project, "Tell Them", focusing on inspiring others to share their faith. It is scheduled for release in the Fall of 2009.

Gaye's transparent presence on stage makes you feel like you've known her for years; and enables her to communicate right to the heart of each individual in the audience. As she begins to sing, it becomes very clear that you are not just going to hear a musical performance, but a word of heart-warming encouragement from God. Her musical style is enjoyed by people of all ages, and ranges from jazz, to gospel, to even a touch of country.



Most of all, she is real – no pretense, no fake religious act; just Gaye Ramsey letting people in on her life, to inspire others to let God in on theirs.

Gaye and her husband, Eric, are full-time evangelists. Eric Ramsey is president of Tom Cox World Ministries. They travel the globe leading others to evangelize people groups around the world. Their love for the local church increases their motivation to see the church be living on mission with God. Eric and Gaye have two teenage children, Andrew and Alisha. They make their home not far from Mountainburg, Arkansas.

Kay was born in Boise, Idaho and is the daughter of former mayor of Boise, Jay Amyx and his wife, Martha. Her father helped establish the Southern Baptist work in the Utah-Idaho Convention. She accepted Christ at age nine and answered the call for mission work at age thirteen. She was unaware she would later marry Dr. Tom Cox and that together they would become International Mission Evangelists.

Kay attended Link's School of Business in Boise, Idaho, the University of Idaho in Moscow and is a graduate of the International Travel Institute of Tulsa.

Kay works full-time for the Tom Cox World Ministries as office coordinator, bookkeeper, and travel arranger as well as actively participating in the nightly crusades. She is in charge of the children's ministry and sings each night. She gives presentations on various parts of the world to schools, civic groups, senior citizen's groups, etc. Mrs. Cox also speaks for lady's events across the country.
